DECREES:

Mr. Raymond Angelo Pacia, Honorary Consul in Providence (United States), in addition to fulfilling the general duties in defense of national interests and protection of its citizens, exercises consular functions limited to:

- a) receipt and transmission to the Consulate General of Italy in Boston of vital records documents received from local authorities, from Italian citizens or from the captains of national or foreign ships or aircraft;
- b) receipt and transmission to the Consulate General of Italy in Boston of statements concerning vital records of the captains of ships and aircraft, or witnesses;
- c) issue of protection deeds, which do not involve the disposal of the assets of Italian citizens, in matters of succession, shipwreck or plane accident, with the obligation to promptly inform the Consulate General of Italy in Boston;
- d) receipt and transmission to the Consulate General of Italy in Boston of applications for registration in the electoral lists in Italy submitted by citizens who are resident in the territorial district of the Honorary Consular Office;
- e) delivery of certifications, issued by the Consulate General of Italy in Boston;
- f) certification of existence in life for pension purposes;
- g) endorsements and legalizations;
- h) capturing the biometric data of Italian citizens requesting an electronic document and subsequently forwarding the data to the Consulate General of Italy in Boston;
- i) receipt and transmission to the Consulate General of Italy in Boston of the documentation relating to requests for the release of the provisional travel document - ETD - submitted by Italian citizens and citizens of EU Member States, after having acquired the report of theft or loss of passport or other travel document and after having carried out the appropriate checks, pursuant to art. 71 of the decree of the President of the Republic 28 December 2000, n. 445, on the truthfulness of the substitutive statements referred to in articles 46 and 47 of the aforementioned decree of the President of the Republic; delivery of the ETDs, issued by the Consulate General of Italy in Boston, valid for a single trip to the Member State of which the applicant is a citizen, to the country of permanent residence or, exceptionally, to another destination;
- j) assistance to fellow citizens in need or in temporary difficulty and carrying out preliminary activities for the purpose of granting subsidies or loans with a promise of restitution to the treasury by the Consulate General of Italy in Boston;
- k) collaboration in updating the register of Italian citizens residing in the Consulate General of Italy in Boston jurisdiction.

This decree will be published in the Official Gazette of the Italian Republic.
