_____, being duly sworn, deposes and says that he is a funeral director, duly licensed by the State of _____, and that he operates a funeral home at _____, that he supervised the preparation of the last remains of _____ for shipment to Italy, and that he certifies and swears that the body has been enclosed in a wooden Italian crypt casket with a zinc liner, hermetically sealed, and placed in a strong wooden box, the boards which are of a thickness of not less than 1 and 3/4 inches, that the boards are in one piece or mortised, that the intersection of the different parts of the box are joined in dove-tail style, and that the joints were first glued together and fastened with screws, that the box is bound with metal strips one (1) inch in width or more and eighteen (18) inches apart, that between the metal casket and the box is a filler of sawdust or wood shavings of a thickness of not less than 1 and 3/4 inches, that the remains were embalmed by a duly licensed embalmer in accordance with the rules and regulations of the department of health of the State of _____ for transportation to Italy.
